


Early Printing (16th Century)

Exceptionally rare collection of poetry by an important Italian humanist








First edition of the most famous and influential copy-book of the mid-16th century

equipment and the others a wide variety of scripts (including Greek, Hebrew, Ethiopic and Arabic)
and rebuses, another sample page showing 2 sizes of rotunda type with upper and lowercase alphabets
and woodcut decorative initials, and 30 pages of letterpress text. Most of the text pages and writing
samples in frames of thick-thin rules, a few in decorative woodcut frames. Old sheepskin parchment
over flexible boards.
