First Dutch edition of an eyewitness account of the 1573 siege of Alkmaar

1st. The Sultan to abolish the foreign Slave Trade for ever in his dominions. 1st. There shall be no dealing in Slaves in our territory, and no Slaves shall be imported to be sold in our country. We positively prohibit it and forbid it absolutely.

Exceptionally rare treaty between the British Empire and the Island of Anjouan to suppress the slave trade

[TREATY - SLAVE TRADE]. Treaty between Her Majesty the Queen of England and the Sultan of Johanna for the suppression of the slave trade.

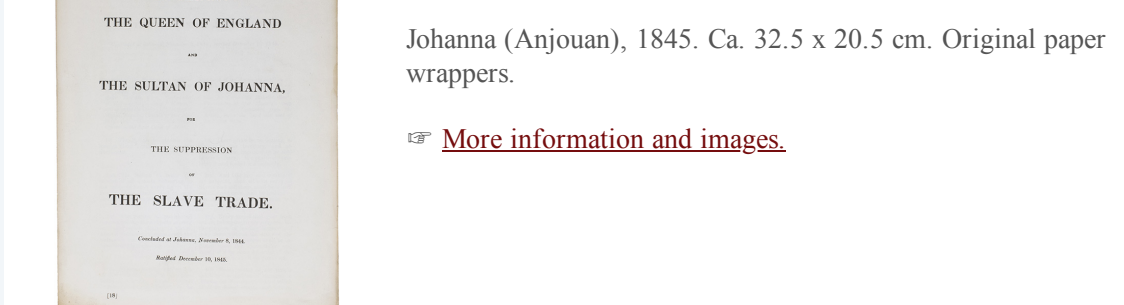
